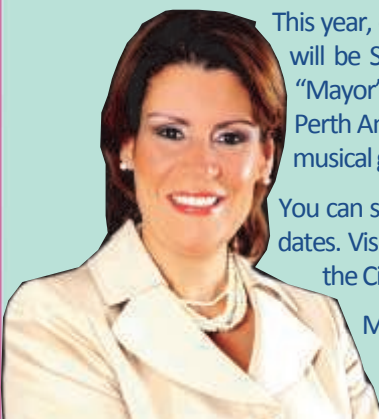

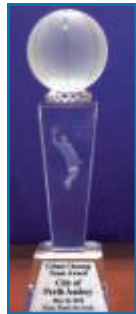

In our Winter 2018 Newsletter we featured some of the awards won by the City and its departments. Well, we are proud to announce that we have won even more since then! Read the highlights below.

2018 Urban Cleanup Team Award

Awarded to the City of Perth Amboy by the New Jersey Clean Communities Council for their strenuous efforts to maintain our city litter-free. Perth Amboy is one of fourteen municipalities that is part of the Urban Cleanup Team of Middlesex County. As a member of this team, the City must host clean-up events that involve not just the Department of Public Works, but also the mayor and public officials, businesses, community organizations, schools and individuals.



Middlesex County 200 Club Valor and Meritorious Service Awards

Several of our police officers and firefighters were recognized by the Middlesex County 200 Club for their courageous and extraordinary service. Detectives Luis Perez and Crescencio Fuentes and Officer Danny Gonzalez received a valor award for their success in rescuing a man attempting to jump from the Victory Bridge. Officer Raphael Bengochea received a valor award for disarming a man armed with a knife.

Detective David Guzman also received a meritorious service award for disarming a man. And Officer Danny Mendes and firefighter Kenneth Febles also received a meritorious service award for saving a woman from a burning vehicle.

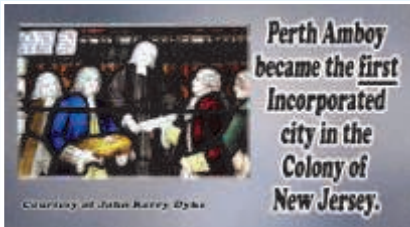
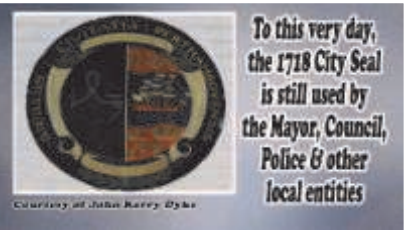


Libraries of Middlesex Awards

The non-profit organization Libraries of Middlesex (LMx) awarded Mayor Diaz and a Perth Amboy Public Library employee with awards. Edwin Olavarria was recognized as Library Employee of the Year due to his thirty-year service to the citizens of Perth Amboy in his position. The Honorable Mayor Wilda Diaz was honored as Public Official of the Year. This award was given to Mayor Diaz in recognition for her active role in the restoration and improvement of the Perth Amboy Free Public Library.

Evangeline Menendez Trailblazer Award

Awarded to Mayor Wilda Diaz by Senator Bob Menendez at his Eighth Annual Women's History Month event. This award is given to New Jersey women for their outstanding achievements in a number of fields such as education, entrepreneurship, and community leadership.



We were awarded a \$2,000 Sustainable Jersey capacity-building grant funded by the PSEG Foundation for the "Green Business Recognition Program" designed to encourage local businesses to take small steps into become more environmentally friendly. This program looks at energy conservation, providing discounts for using a reusable bag, using recycled products to conduct business, and other action items in order to save the business money while promoting a healthier environment for the people of the City and the City itself.

This Green Business Recognition offers a twofold opportunity in promoting a healthier environment, while advancing the initiatives of our local businesses. I want to thank the Sustainable Jersey Grant for supporting the vision and initiatives of the City of Perth Amboy, as we aim to build a cleaner environment for our entire community," said Mayor Wilda Diaz.


